Registration with the Danish authorities – for students of EU citizenship

On 8 September 2023, Student Services Kolding has arranged for the Danish authorities to receive applications for EU residency. It is **VERY important** that you follow the instructions sent to you by e-mail, as it would otherwise delay your possibility of subsequently getting your Danish CPR number (yellow health insurance card). There are two steps in this process; first, EU registration in Odense, and then registration with the municipality in Kolding to get your yellow health insurance card. The date for the EU registration is fixed and cannot be moved; we are still planning the date for the registration with the municipality.

Friday 12 or 13 September 2023 – at Borgerservice Kolding Registration at Borgerservice

On either 12 or 13 September, we have arranged for our newly arrived international students to go to the city hall, where Borgerservice will register your entry into Denmark and issue your CPR number. As an EU student, you must first obtain your EU registration certificate (see above), and as a non-EU student, you must have your residence permit in order to be registered and get your Danish CPR number. We will provide further details in a separate e-mail.
